JOB SUMMARY

Traditions Recovery Center for Women (TRC), a facility in Lawrenceville, Ga., under the ownership of MARR Addiction Treatment Centers, is seeking a contract therapist with expertise in disordered eating. The therapist will be responsible for delivering 5-10 hours (negotiable based on need) of services to clients enrolled in TRC's Disordered Eating (DE) Program.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Clients deemed appropriate for the Disordered Eating Program at Traditions Recovery Center for Women have a primary substance use disorder (SUD) diagnosis, as well as exhibit co-occurring conditions related to the following:

- Preoccupation with food
- Preoccupation with body image
- Preoccupation with exercise
- Dishonesty around eating/exercise patterns
- Attempts to use/control food intake to change emotions.

Clients are not required to fit the diagnostic criteria of eating disorder or eating disorder NOS in order to participate in the Disordered Eating Program. MARR Addiction Treatment Centers' exclusionary criteria includes active bingeing and purging, active food





restriction, and the unwillingness or inability to discontinue these behaviors during the course of treatment.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Psychoeducation group therapy on body acceptance and other disordered eating/nutrition topics
- Supportive meal group
- Individual therapy sessions for clients enrolled in the Disordered Eating Program
- Disordered eating intake assessments
- Complete documentation according to MARR Addiction Treatment Centers' policies and procedures. Documentation includes but is not limited to:
 - Individual and group therapy notes
 - Assessments documentation
 - Incident reports
 - Treatment planning
- Consult with treatment team and other providers
